

Assignment 4: Media Tool Presentation (15%)

The purpose of this assignment is to research the pedagogical and technical possibilities related to an online media development or distribution tool or platform. This assignment has two components: a written report (*8 marks*) and a group presentation (*7 marks*). As a group you will write a short report in blog post form of no more than 500 words excluding references, and share your findings in a synchronous group presentation of no more than 10 minutes excluding participant questions. Your synchronous presentation can take place within a web-conferencing tool provided by TRU or by another tool of your choosing (please clear alternate tools with the course instructor). Your blog post must accept comments for others to ask questions or engage in discussion and your synchronous presentation must include time for participant questions.

Working in groups of 2 or 3, your research, report, and presentation will centre on one specific platform or tool that allows you to create or edit media, and/or allows you to distribute media. Your Open Learning Faculty Member must approve the platform or tool before you begin. An appropriate media platform would be a web-based service that allows you to host media and share it with others, like YouTube. An online tool would be a web-based site that allows you to create or edit media (e.g., Google Draw). The presentation and report should address these topics:

- 1) Academic or informal writing on the educational benefits of the tool or platform including:
 - Published research on the educational use of the specific tool/platform or on similar tools or platforms
 - Writing from educational bloggers or other non-academic sources
- 2) Aspects of tool use by instructors including:
 - Ease of use
 - How it supports pedagogically-sound development, configuration, or distribution of media
 - How it supports accessibility and universal design for learning
- 3) Aspects of tool use by students including:
 - Suitability for individual student and group use
 - Appropriateness for project-based learning
